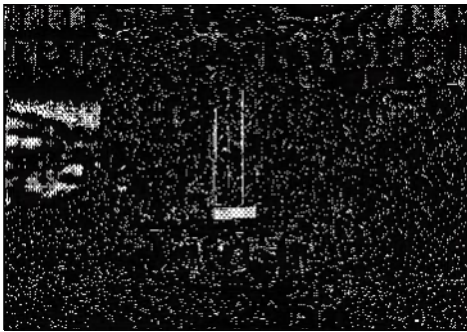

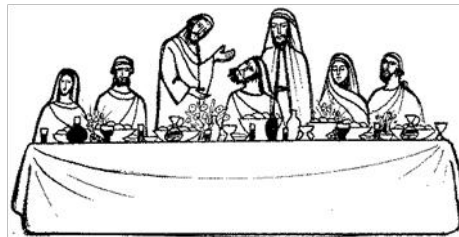
Hope you have all had a good holiday, are refreshed and ready to plunge headlong back into work, school or whatever it is that is the 'norm' for you.

We are introducing a weekly evening Mass to facilitate the opportunity for those who work to attend a weekly Mass if they want to. My old priest used to say "Mass on Sunday is our obligation; Mass mid week is the 'extra mile' walked with love." We have chosen *Thursday* evening at *7.30pm*.

Also, a reminder to all, and if parents could remind the children, when we receive the Sacrament into the hand, hands should be cupped and raised to the priest, then the sacrament is consumed before setting off for the chalice or back to our seats.
