### 3rd March 2024 Third Sunday of Lent (page 154 of Parish Mass Book) YEAR B

Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne? Though she may forget I will not forget you! Is 49.15

Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine. Is 43.1

When we listen to the teachings of Jesus as expressed by the leaders of the Church, we may find them challenging. Questions arise in our minds about how this demonstrates God's love towards us. We may experience strong emotions & become upset. All of that is valid; we all have the right to feel what we feel & to be upset. Emotions are God-given & cannot be inherently bad or wrong.

Sometimes, these emotions are intense, & we simply need time. Our emotions will subside at some point. Emotions are not sins; however, what we do with them may become a sin, as sin is something that does not help us to blossom or flourish.

In all of this, we deserve compassion towards ourselves, acknowledging what we experience. All with patience & empathy. God desires our well-being always, even if we feel strongly about something. He loves us & desires our wholeness this is why He is always clear or even firm when presenting us with the truth.

Issues like contraception, abortion, IVF, euthanasia, & others can make these experiences more challenging. Fair enough! There is plenty in those issues that evoke strong feelings within us. We need time to feel them, to be upset, to mourn, & to express our emotions. It would be good to come to a priest & have a chat. It would be useful to read about it & ask questions. Let's allow ourselves to share our struggles, doubts, and fears. Always with kindness & mutual respect. All of that is a part of a process.

Experiencing those struggles is not the end; we all feel that it is not a place to be. We all feel that we deserve change, peace, & healing. Again, it takes time, compassion, and courage to move forward. Yet, when we are ready, always when we are ready. This cannot be forced. It can be only encouraged & nurtured. In the meantime, it is good to pray, to talk about it, & to support each other.

The teachings of the Church cannot change on some matters. However, it is obvious that we are on a journey together to help each other in a deeper understanding of God's desire for our happiness.

Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light. Matt 11.28-30
