There is a great Jesuit tradition known as the Examen. At the end of the day, as you crawl into bed, it is a good exercise to review the day and give thanks to God for all the wonderful things that you experienced. In addition, it is good to see if there are any things that you could have said or done differently. You might look at your day and see where you acted with integrity and where you can improve tomorrow.

Integrity is one of the virtues that is spoken of often in the scripture, not least in today's Gospel where Jesus warns the people to do as the Scribes and Pharisees say but ignoring the things they do. Being true to yourself is a phrase people often use when giving advice, and for us, wishing to follow Christ, we must see ourselves as made in the image and likeness of God. So to be our true and best selves, for us to have any integrity at all, we are called to be that image of God as consistently as we can, which involves asking God every day to help us on our journey. That surely is the main focus of a disciples prayer.

As you know, we are committed to supporting a Syrian family fleeing the horror of what is happening in their country. We have a very effective team in place to assist the family in all aspects of life as they seek to make a home in the strange surroundings of a foreign land.
