9th April 2017 Palm Sunday (page 176 of Parish Mass Book) YEAR A

Today we begin Holy Week - an opportunity for us to accompany Jesus on his final journey. Jesus enters Jerusalem as a humble, gentle bearer of Good News riding on a donkey but is received as a celebrity; the spreading of garments and branches on the road was a form of homage for an important person (a bit like our red carpet). However very quickly, on that same journey he suffered betrayal, torture, crucifixion and death.



We see the hatred of Caiphas and the religious leaders who plotted his death. We see the evil of Judas who betrayed him. We see the weakness of Peter who disowned him, the cruelty of Herod who mocked him, the cowardice of Pilate, who, though knowing he was innocent, signed the death warrant etc.

However, we also see the compassion of Veronica who wiped his face, the courage of Simon who helped him to carry the cross, the sympathy of the women of Jerusalem and the steadfast loyalty of a little group of friends who stayed with him to the end, including his mother and the disciple John.

The road of suffering is difficult. But for Christians it is not the same since Jesus travelled it. A light brightens it. And even though it leads to Calvary, it doesn't end there. It ends at Easter. Those who suffer with him on earth will share his glory in heaven.

Do all you can to attend ALL the Holy Week ceremonies that we may be more compassionate, loyal and supportive of all who suffer and give thanks for the love and support we receive in carrying our own crosses.
