The people of Samaria were ignored and marginalized by the majority. And yet, consistently in the Gospels, these unwelcome outsiders are received positively by Jesus. He holds them up as shining examples of discipleship in his parables and miracles.

See how the Samaritan expressed his gratitude: He gave glory to God in a loud voice and fell at Jesus' feet to thank him. This attitude of praise should lie at the heart of every disciple of Christ. Jesus tells the grateful man to GO! Go out and proclaim God's praise! Why? Because his faith has saved him.

In the Second Reading from Saint Paul's Second Letter to Timothy, the apostle proclaims: Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead. . . Such is the gospel, for which I am suffering, even to the point of chains. But the Word of God is not chained. . .

The Word of God is not chained! Not by ignorance, not by hatred, not by prejudice. Today, Jesus challenges us to ask ourselves as individuals and communities: Whom do we openly or silently marginalize as outsiders? Perhaps their very presence among us might be an opportunity to learn something about God's welcoming embrace. (ocp)
