PRINCIPLES OF MORAL JUDGMENT

Flourishing - God has called us to flourish - to achieve the highest level of humanity as He desired. God wants us to flourish. In a sense, flourishing is our human vocation. Human beings don't simply exist.

Freedom - from and for so that we can achieve the highest level of flourishing, the deepest level of fulfilment of what it means to be human.

Divine Law - is that which is enacted by God & made known to man through revelation. **Natural Law** -The natural law expresses the original moral sense which enables man to discern by reason the good and the evil, the truth and the lie. The natural law is written and engraved in the soul of each and every man, because it is human reason ordaining him to do good and forbidding him to sin

Conscience - God's voice within each individual.

- Basic moral teachings of Christ: What do Christ and his disciples say that relates to the issue? Thinking critically, what did they mean?
- Related developments: Has the Church changed its guidance on this issue over the centuries?
- *Human nature*: How does this moral issue interact with the basic facts of our existence? Is our decision, action, behaviour, or attitude in line with how God created us (in His image)?
- Human dignity: Does this issue or our decision, action, behaviour, or attitude towards it — embody and engender respect for others made in the image of God?
- *Common good*: How does a particular decision, action, behaviour, or attitude contribute to or detract from the good of humankind as a whole?
- Freedom: Does a particular action or behaviour allow someone to live freely in accordance with their nature? Does the action or behaviour impede their growth as a human being? Are they essentially living in harmony with God's plan while exercising their free will?
