CHILDREN'S LITURGY: VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR 11.30AM MASSES

We are delighted to confirm that we will be holding Children's Liturgy sessions during some 11.30am Masses - with thanks to a new leader who has come forward to run them! The first one will take place at Mass on Sunday 28th April.

We are now recruiting a small team of volunteers to help, without whom we won't be able to offer these sessions. In terms of the time commitment, volunteers arrive 15-20 mins before Mass and carry out the role during the Mass itself. Volunteers usually help at 4-6 masses each year. No experience required — you'll be fully briefed before each session.

Helping involves setting up and resetting the hall, as well as supporting with arts and craft activities. There is no 'typical' volunteer — some of our existing team members are students in secondary school or sixth form, others are parents whose children attend sessions, whilst many are people who simply enjoy engaging with and encouraging our younger parishioners.
