**GDPR**. It is going to be a headache for us and for most parishes I suspect. It stands for General Data Protection Regulations and they come into force on 25<sup>th</sup> May. In short we will be changing the way we store data, moving to electronic storage off site, with the bare minimum of hard copy stuff being kept and that for the shortest space of time. To this end, all volunteers, who have any paper work that belongs to the church, with the exception of rotas (which may contain a telephone number for working purposes) to return it to the parish office so that it may be securely destroyed, it is not enough for you to shred it yourselves!

We need also to devise a process to review and clean the data base, informing every member of the congregation of the data we hold on them and for what purpose, and asking permission to retain it. At present we have over 10,000 entries, with 1100 mass attendance. There are programs that allow individuals to update their own data, and we will be looking at whether any suit our needs, as it is not practicable to employ a data coordinator or expect the secretaries to absorb this extra work on a regular basis.

There are many other things we will need to adopt or tighten up, but I think these are the main points. Your cooperation and prayers will be much appreciated.
