This Week

This week we have moved on to the chapter 'Fruit of the Vine'.

We are still thinking about the Eucharistic prayer, and how this is a prayer of thanksgiving. The word Eucharist means Thanksgiving.

During our class this week, we have laid out a table ready for a party (candles, special food, special glasses and plates, flowers and a tablecloth) and laid out a special table (the altar), ready for Mass (chalice, paton, flowers, hosts, and wine.) We have looked at how the two compare.

In this way, we hope to introduce the children to the idea that, when we go to Mass, Jesus invites us to share a special meal with him.

Please help your child to watch during the Mass for the offertory and the Eucharistic prayer, when the altar is prepared for the special meal.
