Happy New Year and welcome to the continuing journey towards your child's First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

Your child should have received the I Belong book at their class this week.

Please take time over the coming weeks to talk to your child and reflect as a family on the beginning of this special year for them, and how this special journey began with their Baptism.

This week, we have talked about the importance of names and listened to stories from both the Old Testament and the New Testament that show the importance of names: Adam naming the animals in the story of creation, and Jesus being named as God's Son at his Baptism. We then began to think about our own Baptism and how we were named. It is at Baptism we become part of God's family; it is the first stepping-stone on our special journey – First Holy Communion.
