We have been thinking about how when we gather to celebrate mass, we are remembering Jesus celebrating the last supper. When we go to mass, Jesus is inviting us to share a special meal with him.

The food we eat when we gather around Jesus' table is food to make our hearts strong. The more we eat this food, the more like Jesus we will become.

We have thought about the words we hear every week at mass during the consecration - exactly the same words used at the last supper.
